



Sensitivity Test Instructions:

Please collect your pack from your local clinic containing your patch test.

This is to be carried out at home at least 48 hours prior to your scheduled appointment.

1. You will be provided with 2 plasters:
 - One impregnated with permanent cosmetic pigment.
 - One impregnated with anaesthetic.
2. Fold back the protective backing on one of the plasters to reveal the pigment.
3. Re- hydrate the pigment by adding a drop of tap water to the plaster.
4. Place the plaster on the top of your left thigh.
5. Repeat this procedure for the second plaster that is impregnated with anaesthetic. In this case placing the plaster on your right thigh.
6. After 24 hours remove the plaster and examine the skin. If there is no reaction, i.e. redness, swelling, irritation or itching it is safe to proceed with your enhancement.
7. Should you experience any of the symptoms mentioned above, remove the plaster and immediately flush the area with cold water.
8. Please contact us to report the test results.

Please note that the correct colour will be mixed for you at your scheduled appointment. The colour is for sensitivity test purposes only.

Please read all the forms in full: Before My Treatment, General Consent, and Medical Questionnaire

Don't forget to let Rosie know of any medical conditions you mark on the form at least 48 hours prior to your scheduled appointment time. Possible contra indications such as a medical condition, long term medication or prescribed medication (highlighted on the medical form) will require the Doctors consent form signed and returned on the day of your appointment. Failure to provide the Doctors consent will prevent Rosie from being able to carry out the treatment on the day. This will result in postponing the treatment and covering losses charged at 75% of the full procedure price.
